	The actuator is connected with a standard control signal of 010 V and drives to the position defined by the control signal. The measuring voltage U serves for the electrical display of the actuator position 0.5100% and as control signal for other actuators.		
	Operation on Bus:		
	The actuator receives its digital control signal from the higher level controller via the MP-Bus and drives to the position defined. Connection U serves as communication interface and does not supply an analogue measuring voltage.		
Converter for sensors	Connection option for a sensor (passive or active sensor or switching contact). The MP actuator serves as an analogue/digital converter for the transmission of the sensor signal via MP-Bus to the higher level system.		
Parametrisable actuators	The factory settings cover the most common applications. Single parameters can be modified with the Belimo Service Tools MFT-P or ZTH EU.

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Mounting on third-party valves	The Retrofit actuators for installation on a wide range of valves from various manufacturers are comprised of an actuator, universal valve neck adapter and universal valve stem adapter. Adapt the valve neck and valve stem to begin with, then attach the Retrofit actuator to the valve neck adapter, connect to the valve and start up. The valve neck adapter/actuator can be rotated by 360° on the valve neck, provided the size of the installed valve permits.	
Mounting on Belimo valves	Use standard actuators from Belimo for mounting on Belimo globe valves.






Parallel connection of other actuators possible. Observe the performance data. Direction of stroke switch factory setting: Actuator stem retracted (**A**).












Control with 4...20 mA via external resistor




Override control with AC 24 V with Control remotely 0...100% with rotary switch

Primary/secondary operation (position-dependent)







Override control and limiting with AC 24 V with relay contacts





Override control and limiting with AC 24 V with rotary switch








The actuator can be parametrised by ZTH EU via the service socket.
